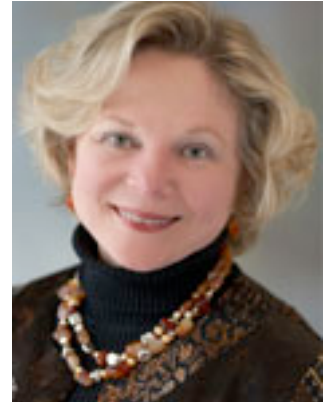


## Linda Koenig, MA Coactive Colleague
